

Metes and Bounds

(Effective: 1 May 1970)

Parish: St. Mary, Star of the Sea **City:** Aransas Pass

(Note: Metes and bounds, except where otherwise stated, extend to the center of streets, railroad tracks, roads, highways, rivers and along shorelines.)

All that territory contained within the city limits of the City of Aransas Pass, San Patricio – Aransas – Nueces Counties, Texas, and extending outside the city limits of Aransas Pass, Texas to include the following territory submerged or above water – East along the Dale Miller Causeway to the junction of the Aransas Channel and the Lydia Ann Channel; thence North along the Lydia Ann Channel and the Intracoastal Waterway; thence West across Red Fish Bay to F. M. Road #188; thence West along F. M. Road #188 to a point where F.M. Road #188 crosses Port Bay (a part of large Copano Bay); thence South in a direct line to McCampbell Road, San Patricio County; thence South along McCampbell Road to a point which would be the intersection of a line drawn East along Mooney Lane, San Patricio County, to the shore line of Red Fish Bay; thence East in a line across Red Fish Bay to intersect the Port Aransas-Corpus Christi Ship Channel; thence North along the Port Aransas-Corpus Christi Ship Channel to where the Port Aransas-Corpus Christi Ship Channel, the Lydia Ann Channel and the Dale Miller Causeway intersect (Harbor Island Dock) to include all submerged lands and the charted islands or spoil banks therein contained, namely – Ransom Island chain, Harbor Island chain, Hog Island chain, Shell Bank Island, the southern tip of Traylor Island and all unnamed spoil banks or reefs attached thereto.
