

Metes and Bounds

(Effective: 15 October 1979)

Parish: St. Rose de Lima **City:** Benavides

(Note: Metes and bounds, except where otherwise stated, extend to the center of streets, railroad tracks, roads, highways, rivers and along shorelines.)

Beginning at a point where Highway #59 crosses Caliche Creek; thence East along an imaginary line to F. M. Road #339 about 10 miles northwest of Benavides and 1 mile southeast of the dirt road connecting F. M. Road #339 and Highway #44; thence Southeast along F. M. Road #339 to latitude 27 40'; thence East along latitude 27 40' to F. M. Road #1329; thence South along F. M. Road #1329 to Olmos School and the intersection of an imaginary line drawn from a point on F. M. Road #359 ten miles southwest of Benavides to a point on the Kleberg-Jim Wells County line 7 miles south of the northwest corner of Kleberg County; thence West along said imaginary line to the point on F. M. Road #359 ten miles southwest of Benavides; thence West along an imaginary line to the southern end of Caliche Creek directly east of Guadalupe Street in Laredo (and its imagined extension directly west) and directly south of the point where Highway #59 crosses Caliche Creek; thence North to the point where Highway #59 crosses Caliche Creek which is the point of beginning.
