## **Metes and Bounds**

(Effective: 1 November 1982)

Parish:	Our Lady of Good Counsel	City: Kingsville

(Note: Metes and bounds, except where otherwise stated, extend to the center of streets, railroad tracks, roads, highways, rivers and along shorelines.)

Beginning at the intersection of King Avenue and 12<sup>th</sup> Street; thence North along 12<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with Santa Gertrudis Avenue; thence East along Santa Gertrudis Avenue to its intersection with 14<sup>th</sup> Street; thence South along 14<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with Tranquitas Creek; thence Southeast along Tranquitas Creek to its intersection with U. S. Highway #77 Bypass; thence North along U. S. Highway #77 By-pass to the point of the projected intersection of it and F. M. Road #2045; thence East along this line and F. M. Road #2045 to its intersection with the San Fernando Creek; thence in a Northerly direction to a point where U. S. Highway #77 By-pass crosses the Nueces-Kleberg County line; thence along the Nueces-Kleberg County line and intercepting to the East Padre Island to the Gulf of Mexico; thence South along the shoreline to a point opposite the east-west F. M. Road #772; thence West along an imaginary line to the Cayo del Grullo; thence in a Northerly direction following the Cayo del Grullo to its intersection with the Escondido Creek; thence following the meanders of the Escondido Creek to its intersection with the Santa Gertrudis Creek to its intersection with F. M. Road #1717; thence North of F. M. Road #1717 intercepting 14<sup>th</sup> Street; and continuing North on 14<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with King Avenue; thence West on King Avenue to its intersection with 12<sup>th</sup> Street which is the point of beginning.
