Beginning at the intersection of 14<sup>th</sup> Street and King Avenue; thence West along King Avenue to its intersection with Armstrong Street; thence North on Armstrong Street to its intersection with Corral Avenue and F. M. Road #1898; thence West along F. M. Road #1898 to its intersection with the southeast corner of Farm Lot 7, Section 8, K. T. & I. Company, and continuing due North to its intersection with the Kleberg-Nueces County line; thence West along the Kleberg-Nueces County line to the Jim Wells County line; thence South along the Jim Wells-Kleberg County line to the Brooks County Line; thence East on the Brooks County line to its intersection with State Highway #285; thence South along the Brooks County line to its intersection with the Kleberg-Kenedy County line; thence East along the Kleberg-Kenedy County line to a point south of the east-west and north-south intersection of F. M. Road #772; thence North along an imaginary line to the corner where the north-south joins the east-west F. M. Road #772; thence East along F. M. Road #772, crossing U. S. Highway #77 and continuing to a point where F. M. Road #772 turns south, continuing east along an imaginary line to a point where it intersects with the Cayo del Grullo; thence in a Northerly direction following the meanders of the Cayo del Grullo to its intersection with Escondido Creek to its intersection with the Santa Gertrudis Creek and following the meanders of the Santa Gertrudis Creek to its intersection with F. M. Road #1717; thence North on F. M. Road #1717, intercepting 14<sup>th</sup> Street, and continuing North on 14<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with King Avenue; thence West along King Avenue to its intersection with Armstrong Street which is the point of beginning.
