

Metes and Bounds

(Effective: 15 October 1979)

Parish: Our Lady of Refuge **City:** Refugio

(Note: Metes and bounds, except where otherwise stated, extend to the center of streets, railroad tracks, roads, highways, rivers and along shorelines.)

Beginning at the point where the Mission River intersects Highway #77; thence upstream along the Mission River and continuing upstream along the meanderings of Medio Creek (as the River decreases in size) to the southeast corner of the Mary and Margaret Murphy land; thence in a Northerly direction along the Mary and Margaret Murphy property line to the southwest corner of the J. L. Peterson estate property; thence North along the west line of the Peterson, McGill and Sullivan lands to the Blanco Creek, which is the common boundary of Bee and Goliad counties; thence South along the Bee-Goliad line to its juncture with the Goliad-Refugio county line; thence North along this line till its junction with Highway #183; thence from this point along an imaginary line extending easterly towards a point where Highway #35 crosses the Refugio-Aransas county line until such imaginary line meets Highway #77; thence South along Highway #77 through the city of Refugio until its intersection with the Mission River which is the point of beginning.
